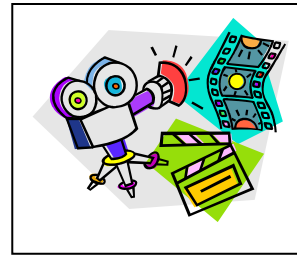
- ❖ **Ancestry Library Edition**, delivers census data, vital records, photos etc. In Library use only. Go to "Reference Desk" tab on the website.
